**Open Wise:** Open Wise is a technology-oriented program open to current 6th and 7th grade boys.

**People Animals Love (PAL):** PAL is an animal studies camp that includes STEM lessons, books, animal visits, field trips, animal care, and assemblies. Learning and caring for animals allows for our most vulnerable youth to make social, emotional and academic gains. PAL will serve students currently in kindergarten through grade 5.

**Girl Scouts:** Girl Scouts will offer a session once a week for up to 25 female students participating in all afternoon programs.

**DC Public Schools Afternoon Program:** The DCPS afterschool program will be based around weekly themes. Students will engage in stories, music and art projects, have daily physical activities, develop a service learning project, and participate in one or more theme-related field trips.
