### Who should apply?

- ❖ DCPS students ages **3 to 6**.
- ❖ Students should **not** be eligible for extended school year (ESY).
- ❖ Designed for children who are typically developing in the area of speech and language and those who are at risk of developing language impairments
- ❖ Camp is **not** appropriate for students with significant language, articulation, phonological or fluency impairments.
- ❖ Goal is to provide enhanced opportunities for language, vocabulary, and phonemic awareness development through a variety of listening, art, and environmental experiences.
- ❖ Camp curriculum is focused on language enrichment and exposure. Speech and language therapy services are **not** provided.
