EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT The ED reported there were currently 13,382 licensees under the Board's purview. 10,134 of them are MDs/DOs.</p> <p>The ED informed the Board that some of the smaller professions that need advisory committees may not be able to staff them, as there are too few licensees actually living in the District. MOTA is continuing its recruitment efforts, and further discussion regarding the residency rule is recommended.</p> <p>The ED informed the Board that BOM staff had a successful meeting with the GMEs regarding this year's renewal cycle for the MTLs. The Board Chair suggested to the Board that during this busy time when it might be helpful if two members at a time would review the incoming applications</p>

OS-16-010 ALL	<p>VISITOR - Pamela Hodge, Management Analyst, Department of Health Care Finance:</p> <p>Will discuss the Home and Community Base Services (HCBS). These services are driven by the beneficiary primary care physician (PCP) and HCFA is having major problems with Physician order's and the Physician understanding Skilled nursing and Personal Care Aide (PCA) services.</p> <p>Was unable to attend. Will reschedule.</p>	

ADDITIONAL DISCUSSION:

- Lauren Ratner of the Department's Community Health Administration (CHA), presented before the Board to discuss data collection during renewal cycles. She explained that CHA is specifically looking for numbers of hours worked in the District, and would like to collaborate with BOM to incorporate this into the Board's Workforce Survey, or develop some other way to collect the data. Ms. Ranter stated CHA has access to \$40,000 in grant money to use toward developing a system or ironing out the existing technical issues with the HRLA system and current Workforce Survey. She informed the Board that their similar collaboration with the Dental Board received a 97% response rate. The Board expressed interest in collaborating and will discuss further.
