The Life Cycle of a Strawberry

Strawberries start out as small white flowers. Once pollinated by bees or other insects, the flower turns into a small green fruit. Then the fruit grows using nutrients from the soil, water, and sun until it turns into a ripe red strawberry! Each fruit has 200 seeds that can each grow into a new strawberry plant!
