RE: Letter of Response for Grievance filed

This letter is in reference to concerns that were brought to the attention of DCPS on 4/26/17 regarding your child, [REDACTED] specifically, in regards to long-term suspension and not receiving the paperwork.

In response, DCPS conducted an investigation which included speaking with you and your child. Based on that investigation, DCPS found the following: [REDACTED] Dean of Students, met with you on April 26th to discuss your student's involvement in the incident and when your student would have his suspension for his actions.

In order to address these issues, DCPS implemented the following measures:

1. [REDACTED] Dean of Students, has resolved the matter with you regarding the student's suspension, that it would be a short term (3 days), and he provided final notice of disciplinary action dated 5/3/17: "Off-site Short-Term Suspension for 3 days, beginning on 05/03/2017 and ending on 05/05/2017 (DCMR- §B2505.1)".

If you are not satisfied with the outcome of this investigation, you have the right to file an appeal within 10 calendar days of receipt of this letter. The appeal must be submitted in writing. Appeal requests may be submitted via U.S. Postal Mail to 1200 First St., 9th Floor; Attn: Resolution Grievance Division or via email at dcps.grievance@dc.gov. You may also contact the U.S. Department of Education, Office on Civil Rights (1-800-421-3481) to report any educational discrimination on the basis of race, sex, disability, etc.
