



RE: Letter of Response for Grievance filed



Dear 

This letter is in reference to concerns that were brought to the attention of DCPS on November 15, 2017 regarding your concerns specifically, in the evening parents are locked out of the school from 3:00pm-3:15pm.

In response, DCPS conducted an investigation which included speaking with you and other persons deemed relevant. Based on that investigation, DCPS found the following:

- Letter was sent out in the beginning of the  SY to families discussing the policy change for dismissal to all  families.
- Parents are allowed to come through the cafeteria side door during dismissal.

In order to address these issues, DCPS implemented the following measures:
