In response, DCPS conducted an investigation which included speaking with you, your child, and other

 - Hasn't received any information in recent months regarding the aforementioned

Based on that investigation, DCPS found the following: Interviewed Upper Classmen Attendance Counselor, regarding prior conversations with student and parent Interviewed AP regarding prior conversations with parent Review of submitted excuse notes for late arrival Interviewed assigned 12th grade AP, about graduation status Interviewed grade level Counselor, about next steps in preparation of students' graduation Interviewed Senior Class Sponsor, about prom dues was contacted on to hear concern and to follow-up with concerns: o Parent reported frustration for not getting calls back when messages were left in the main office Discussed rationale for not accepting those notes for lateness to school Student notes for days absent as long as it fit approved guidelines reasons were accepted and excused Reported that is on track to graduate o Parent was reminded about the methods the school used to notify parents about graduation and prom next steps (Graduation/prom packets were mailed information about prom and fudiciary needs were provided on when took her senior pictures (fact sheet was provided) senior parent meeting was held during the evening of senior parent meeting was held during the evening of Parent recalled speaking regarding these senior activities Parent was provided the names of the individuals who are responsible for any 12th grade concerns moving forward Encouraged parent to speak with about being late to her 1st block and skinny courses
