This letter is in reference to concerns that were brought to the attention of DCPS on March 7, 2018 regarding your daughter, Specifically, allegations of inappropriate staff treatment.

In response, DCPS conducted an investigation which included speaking with you and other persons identified as witnesses and/or deemed relevant. Based on that investigation, DCPS found the following:

DCPS Grievance conduct observation of the alleged teacher on March 13, 2018 and March 15, 2018.

In order to address these issues, DCPS implemented the following measures:

- 1. A mediation was held on March 16, 2018 with you, and Chief Integrity Officer to discuss your concerns.
- 2. You were provided the Discretionary Transfer Policy and Application on March 9, 2018 via email.

If you are not satisfied with the outcome of this investigation, you have the right to file an appeal within 10 calendar days of receipt of this letter. The appeal must be submitted in writing. Appeal requests may be submitted via U.S. Postal Mail to 1200 First St., 9th Floor; Attn: Resolution Grievance Division or via email at dcps.grievance@dc.gov. You may also contact the U.S. Department of Education, Office on Civil Rights (1-800-421-3481) to report any educational discrimination on the basis of race, sex, disability, etc.
