

This letter is in reference to concerns that were brought to the attention of DCPS on April 18, 2018 regarding your student, Specifically, not receiving suspension paperwork for the identifying alternative solutions to suspensions, incorrect attendance records for bullying allegations.
DCPS conducted an investigation which included speaking with person(s) deemed relevant. Based on the findings of the investigation, the reported actions do not constitute a violation of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations. However, to address your concerns, the following actions were implemented:
follows Chapter 25 Disciplinary Procedures for all students as well as following correct procedures for all incidents involving Assistant Principal hand delivered you the suspension paperwork on for Tier 3 infraction of obscene language. If you are not satisfied with the outcome of this investigation, you have the right to file an appeal within 10 calendar days of receipt of this letter. The appeal must be submitted in writing.
