RE: Letter of Response for Grievance filed



This letter is in reference to concerns that were brought to the attention of DCPS on July 9, 2018 regarding your student, Specifically, you expressed concern about the cademic performance in reading and the schools failure to properly identify him as a student in need of summer academic programming. Additionally, you expressed concern about the criteria used for referral of students into DCPS summer programming.

In response, DCPS conducted an investigation which included speaking with you and other persons identified as witnesses and/or deemed relevant.


was not enrolled in a summer school program at time of your grievance filing.

In order to address these issues, DCPS implemented the following measures:

- 1. DCPS enrolled into ummer school program began attending summer school July 11, 2018.
- 2. DCPS will review retention and summer school remediation criteria to ensure qualifying students are properly referred to summer programming

If you are not satisfied with the outcome of this investigation, you have the right to file an appeal within 10 calendar days of receipt of this letter. The appeal must be submitted in writing. Appeal requests may be submitted via U.S. Postal Mail to 1200 First St., 9<sup>th</sup> Floor; Attn: Resolution Grievance Division or via email at dcps.grievance@dc.gov. You may also contact the U.S. Department of Education, Office on Civil Rights (1-800-421-3481) to report any educational discrimination on the basis of race, sex, disability, etc.
