In accordance with Chapter 24 Subtitle 5-B, Section 2405 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, DC Public Schools (DCPS) Comprehensive Alternative Resolution and Equity team has completed its investigation of the above referenced written grievance.

## **Grievance Issues**

We acknowledge that there has been a lapse in time since the filing of this grievance. Based on a review of the information provided, the written grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

1. 24 DCMR Subtitle 5-B, Section 2405.2 (f): Any other violation of a right granted by law that does not have a specific grievance procedure or hearing process provided in this title. You raise concerns that the heating system at worked consistently.

## **Review Procedure**

The review included interviews with the following individuals:

## **General Findings of Fact**

1. and DCPS reported to DCPS CARE that has experienced chronic heating issues due to a heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) system in need of repair, however, space heaters were provided as a temporary solution.

## **Discussion/Conclusion**

As a result of this review, DCPS has found the following:

1. DCPS finds that **24 DCMR Subtitle 5-B, Section 2405.2 (f)** is substantiated. According to reports from both DCPS Facilities system at has not been working consistently.

In order to ensure your concerns are addressed, DCPS has taken or will take the following actions:

- 1. The DCPS Facilities team will provide space heaters to the HVAC system is repaired.
- 2. The DCPS Facilities team is working with the Department of General Services to replace the aluminum piping on the HVAC system at 2021 school year.

As the complainant, if you are not satisfied with the outcome, you have the right to file an appeal. Appeals must be submitted in writing and received within 10 calendar days of receipt of this notice.
