RE: Letter of Response for Grievance #3029 filed on March 26, 2019



In accordance with Chapter 24 Subtitle 5-B, Section 2405 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, D.C. Public Schools (DCPS) Comprehensive Alternative Resolution and Equity (CARE) team has completed its review of the above referenced written grievance.

## **Grievance Issues**

We acknowledge that there has been a lapse in time since the filing of this grievance. Based on a review of the information provided, the written grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

1. 5-B DCMR 2405.2 (c): Where it is alleged that any student or group of students is being subjected to an arbitrary or unreasonable regulation, procedure, or standard of conduct. You reported that your transcript contained a grade for a class you had not taken. Additionally, you reported that you contacted your school to change the transcript but was told it could not be changed.

## **Discussion/Conclusion**

On April 14, 2020 the DCPS CARE team received your verbal request to have this grievance withdrawn. DCPS CARE attempted to obtain your withdrawal in writing or get additional information regarding your original grievance filing but were unable to do so despite multiple attempts. As a result of the lack of evidence, the CARE Team is unable to issue a finding on 5-B DCMR 2405.2 (c).

As the complainant, if you are not satisfied with the outcome, you have the right to file an appeal. Appeals must be submitted in writing and received within 10 calendar days of receipt of this notice.
