RE: Letter of Response for Grievance #3154 filed on May 2, 2019

In accordance with 24 DCMR Subtitle 5-B, Section 2405 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, DC Public Schools (DCPS) Comprehensive Alternative Resolution and Equity (CARE) team has completed its preliminary investigation of the above referenced grievance.

Based on a review of the information provided, the grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

- **5-B DCMR 2405.2(e)** Where a student is a victim of bullying or harassment, including sexual harassment.
  - On May 2, 2019, it was reported that Student A pulled down his pants and underwear before reaching a toilet and as walked past Student A to leave the restroom, Student A urinated on .

The preliminary investigation included reviewing the incident report, speaking with Assistant Principal, , and a conversation with the parent of Student A<sup>1</sup>. As a result of this review, we have found that the claim does not warrant further investigation based on the age of the students and the behavior described is not considered to be "sexual in nature". This matter is considered closed at this time.

As the complainant, if you are not satisfied with the outcome, you have the right to file an appeal. Appeals must be submitted in writing and received within 10 calendar days of receipt of this notice.
