In accordance with Subtitle 5-B, Section 2405 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, D.C. Public Schools (DCPS) Comprehensive Alternative Resolution and Equity (CARE) team has completed its preliminary investigation of the above referenced written grievance.

## **Grievance Issues**

Based on a review of the information provided, the written grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

5-B DCMR 2405.2 (e): Where a student is a victim of bullying or harassment, including sexual harassment. It is alleged Student A forced Student to engage in sexual acts, including kissing and touching. These allegations fall under Federal Title IX Law of the Education Amendment of 1972 ("Title IX"). Title IX prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex which includes sexual harassment and sexual violence.

The preliminary investigation included speaking with the **Social Worker**, **Social Worker**,
