In accordance with Chapter 24 Subtitle 5-B, Section 2405 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, D.C. Public Schools (DCPS) Comprehensive Alternative Resolution and Equity (CARE) team has completed its review of the above referenced written grievance.

## **Grievance Issues**

Based on a review of the information provided, the written grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

**1. 5-B DCMR 2405.2(c):** Where it is alleged that any student or group of students is being subjected to an arbitrary or unreasonable regulation, procedure, or standard of conduct.

The following has been alleged:

- a. During the Academic Year, you created a hostile learning environment for students by being verbally abusive to students, belittling them, and yelling at them without due cause.
- b. During the Academic Year, you questioned at least two students about their religious beliefs.
- c. On or around and your presented a chart to your classes outlining the differences between and families, which made multiple students feel offended and/or uncomfortable.

1. A referral was sent to Labor Management and Employee Relations (LMER) on the review and investigation of these allegations. Any findings and any disciplinary actions taken will
