In accordance with Chapter 24 Subtitle 5-B, Section 2405 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, D.C. Public Schools (DCPS) Comprehensive Alternative Resolution and Equity (CARE) team has completed its review of the above referenced written grievance.

Grievance Issues

Based on a review of the information provided, the written grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

1. **5-B DCMR 2405.2 (e)**: Where a student is a victim of bullying or harassment, including sexual harassment. It is alleged that while students participated in a baseball camp at **a students** and **b** and and **b** and **b** and and **b** and **b** and **a**

teacher grabbed students' bottoms and

. Additionally, it is alleged Teacher told students

as they did push-ups and told students

These allegations fall under Federal Title IX Law of the Education Amendment of 1972 ("Title IX"). Title IX prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex which includes sexual harassment and sexual violence.

Conclusion

DCPS has taken the following action as a result of these allegations:

1. A referral was sent to Labor Management Employee Relations (LMER) on the review and investigation of these allegations. Their findings and any disciplinary actions will remain confidential due to employee privacy guidelines.

As the complainant, if you are not satisfied with the outcome, you have the right to file an appeal. Appeals must be submitted in writing and received within 10 calendar days of receipt of this notice.
