In accordance with Title 5 Education, Subtitle 5-B, Chapter 24, Subsection 2405 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR), D.C. Public Schools (DCPS) Comprehensive Alternative Resolution and Equity (CARE) team has completed its review of the above-referenced written grievance.

Grievance Issues

The information provided raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

1. **5-B DCMR Subtitle 2405.1 (d) & (e):** Where it is alleged that there has been a violation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 which prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color and national origin, and the D.C. Human Rights Act of 1977 which, in part, prohibits discrimination on the basis of race and color. It was reported Student called someone

The preliminary review included speaking with you, the Parent of Student According to the incident report, Student called someone during transition. DCPS CARE has not been able to confirm the identity of the person that was speaking to. Additionally, DCPS CARE did not receive consent to interview Student Because DCPS CARE does not have information on who was speaking to, we are unable to further investigate this matter and will be closing the case at this time.

You have the right to file an appeal. Appeals must be submitted in writing and received within 10 calendar days of receipt of this notice.
