RE: Letter of Response for Case #4276 received on January 11, 2022

Dear [REDACTED]:

In accordance with Section 405, PARENT, GUARDIAN, AND VISITOR GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, DC Public Schools (DCPS) Comprehensive Alternative Resolution and Equity (CARE) team has completed its preliminary investigation of the above referenced matter.

Based on a review of the information provided, the grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

Section 405 (3)c Where an individual is a victim of bullying or harassment, including sexual harassment;

- a. It is alleged that Student A created a Twitter post advertising an Onlyfans account in Teacher [REDACTED]'s name.

The preliminary investigation included speaking with you on January 12, 2022. Additionally, we spoke with Teacher [REDACTED], Student A, Student B, and Student C. During our interview with you, you stated that Student B reported that Student A created an Onlyfans account on Twitter that included Teacher [REDACTED]'s last name. Teacher [REDACTED], who was also present, corroborated that Student B reported this to [REDACTED]. Student B also reported to DCPS CARE that they saw a Twitter account with the handle [REDACTED] post a tweet about an Onlyfans account with Teacher [REDACTED]'s last name in the description. Student B reported they did not open the link and was unsure of the contents of the Onlyfans account. Student A reported they did not create the Twitter post or Onlyfans account. Student A also reported that they were unaware of the Twitter post and the Onlyfans account until they were questioned about it by [REDACTED] administration on January 11. The [REDACTED] Twitter account is deactivated and unable to be searched. DCPS CARE attempted to Google combinations of "Twitter", [REDACTED], "Onlyfans", and Teacher [REDACTED]'s last name but was unable to find any results that corroborated the existence of the post or account. No one interviewed had screenshots or pictures of the Twitter post or Onlyfans account. With the information available at this time, DCPS CARE is unable to substantiate that Student A created the Twitter post or the Onlyfans account. As a result of this review, we have found that the allegation does not warrant further investigation. This matter is considered closed at this time.

If you are not satisfied with the outcome, you have the right to file an appeal. Appeals must be submitted in writing and received within 10 calendar days of receipt of this notice.
