The Solicitation has been amended as follows:					
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Amendment N.01 corrects the solicitation number on the first page from GAGA-2021-I-0184 to GAGA-2024-I-0184. It also changes the market type from Open to Open with sub-contraction Set aside. (See the attachment Exhibit A) Amendment N.01 adds Section B.7 as follows: B.7.1 NONPROFIT FAIR COMPENSATION ACT OF 2020, D.C. Code § 2-222.01 et seq. Nonprofit organizations, as defined in the Act, shall include in their rates the indirect costs incurred in the provision of goods or performance of services under this contract pursuant to the nonprofit organization's unexpired Negotiated Indirect Cost Rate Agreement (NICRA). If a nonprofit organization does not have an unexpired NICRA, the nonprofit organization may elect to instead include in its rates its indirect costs: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> As calculated using a de minimis rate of 10% of all direct costs under this contract. By negotiating a new percentage indirect cost rate with the awarding agency. 					

(3) As calculated with the same percentage indirect cost rate as the nonprofit organization negotiated with any District agency within the past 2 years; however, a nonprofit organization may request to renegotiate indirect cost rates in accordance with B.7.2 or

(4) As calculated with a percentage rate and base amount, determined by a certified public accountant, as defined in the Act, using the nonprofit organization's audited financial statements from the immediately preceding fiscal year, pursuant to the OMB Uniform Guidance, and certified in writing by the certified public accountant.

3. Amendment N.01 responds to Vendors' questions(Q&A)

Question 1: We understand that the requested Interactive Flat Panel usually comes with ongoing annual subscription charges. We want to bid on a highly similar and competitively priced solution that does not have ongoing annual subscriptions or charges after the initial purchase. Would this be possible and considered?

Response 1: No. The district thoroughly tests and standardizes solutions to ensure optimal support, training, and adoption.

Question 2: In our experience, electrically powered adjustable height stands for Interactive Flat Panels are often heavier to roll around for teachers (as the electrical components only control the height) and more expensive than manual height (non-electrical) adjustable stands that are available in the market. While we can bid on the electrically powered ones, could we also bid on the manual height version, and would they be considered?

Response 2: No. The district thoroughly tests and standardizes solutions across the board to ensure optimal support, training, and adoption.

Question 3: If the wiring requested below needs to be behind the wall, the contractor shall wire and install one (1) wall plate with an HDMI input as close as possible to the teacher workstation/podium/desk up to 15 ft.


Response 3: The district's preference is to have all wires embedded behind the walls. However, embedding the cables in an over-the-wall cable conduit will be accepted for concrete or cinderblock walls.
