

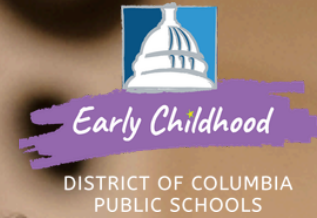


LEARN AND PLAY AT DCPS!
