


## SY 2021-22 COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL PLAN SNAPSHOT Janney Elementary School, Principal Danielle Singh

Our teachers and members of the student support team strategically teach social-emotional learning in whole and small group settings. At the same time, we provide supports to families struggling with attendance.	We will leverage our grade level and content team structures to engage teachers in feedback cycles. Administrators will also use these structures to celebrate and acknowledge specific staff members and the broader team.
