



## SY24-25 School Feeder Patterns

Below are the SY24-25 DCPS school feeder patterns. A feeder pattern school is one that a student has the right to attend based on their current school. This assignment only happens during the year a student is moving from the terminal grade of their current school. Note: Feeder patterns are subject to evolve as new student assignment phase-in policies and grandfathering clauses take effect.<sup>1</sup> The feeder patterns reflected below are active for students transitioning grades between SY23-24 and SY24-25.
