- ❖ DCPS students grades 2nd to 5th.
- ❖ Students should *not* be eligible for extended school year (ESY).

- ❖ Camp program concentrates on providing the students with strategies and techniques to cope and excel in a school or social setting.
- ❖ We are utilizing evidence-based practices and teaching strategies for children struggling with emotional and social challenges through a variety of direct activities.
