## <u>AMENDMENT NO.1</u> GAGA-2021-R-0037 Vendor's Questions

- Question 1. At the pre-bid meeting, we were told to submit Subcontractor Agreements for the base year only, not for the option years, and to include the full pricing structure in the appropriate section in the RFP. Page 2 of the Subcontractor Agreement form requests the "Total Dollar Amount of the Contract" and the % of Total Dollar Amount of Contract for SBE. Can you please clarify how you would like us to complete page 2 of the Subcontractor Agreement form given the direction to complete it for the base year only (not including the option years)?
- **Response 1**. Contracts are awarded based on funding approved in the base year. Therefore, Total Dollar Amount of the Contract" and the 50% of Total Dollar Amount of Contract for all CBEs, is calculated for base year only. When DCPS exercise the option to extend the contract for another year, DCPS will require the contractor to submit a new subcontracting plan for that option year being extended.
- Question 2. We are prepared to institute the 50% subcontracting requirement but have not yet been able to locate a subcontracting plan that has the 50% portion listed, only the older form with 35%.
