Afternoon Programs at Beers ES

Two partner organizations will offer afternoon programming at Beers ES this summer, from 1:00 to 5:30 pm. The programs are free of charge and will provide enrichment for students participating in summer school.

Students have to be enrolled in summer school before enrolling in these afternoon programs.

- **Educational Dimensions:** Program participants will enjoy instruction in reading, writing, mathematics, science and social studies through brain-based active engagement. Educational enrichment activities, provided by the National Geographic Society's D. C. Geographic Alliance trained teacher consultants, will be geography-based and will include field experiences, geographical exploration, and a range of project- and problem-based activities.
- Educational Dimensions will serve a maximum of **120 students in grades K-5.**
- **People. Animals. Love. (PAL) Camp:** PAL is a summer program centered around bringing wildlife inside and outside of the classroom. This summer we will be taking a Safari around the world, highlighting continents such as Africa and Asia. Students will be engaged reading and writing about these experiences and they will have the opportunity to attend field trips to enhance the Safari theme. Students will read, write and participate in hands on activities each afternoon.
- PAL will serve a maximum of **100 students in grades K-5.**
