 <u>Diamond Dream Foundation (DDF)</u>: DDF ALL-STARS Afterschool is a multi-dimensional program developed to enrich the lives of our All-Stars, their families and communities, through daily afterschool curriculum that fosters these five core values:

**Nutrition**. How to eat healthy and why it matters with emphasis on making positive choices and habits. **Health**. What it means to take care of one's self with topics of discussion that range from bullying and addiction to life goals and relationships and how to prioritize what's important.

**Life Enhancement.** Exploration of the arts, music, dance, crafts and positive self-expression. **Education**. Guidance, tutoring and focused study time to improve learning skills and techniques. **Sports/Activities**. Building confidence and self-esteem through team plan and fitness activities and providing fun ways to "unplug" from cell phones, computers, TV's and other electronic devices.

Diamond Dream Foundation will serve a maximum of 70 students in grades K-7.
