



# Summer School

## Afternoon Programs at Bruce-Monroe @ Park View ES

Two partner organizations will offer afternoon programming at Bruce-Monroe @ Park View ES this summer, from 1:00 to 5:30 pm. The programs are free of charge and will provide enrichment for students participating in summer school.

**Students have to be enrolled in summer school before enrolling in these afternoon programs.**

- **Capitol Education Support (CES):** Students will enjoy academic and art enrichment programming. Students will also participate in yoga, sports and arts and crafts.
- Capitol Education Support will serve a maximum of **75 students in grades K-5.**
- **Latin American Youth Center (LAYC):** Students in 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> grade will be engaged in an academic, cultural and community project-based learning experience. In addition to working on grade-appropriate academic skills with DCPS teachers in the morning, students will spend the afternoon learning about different cultures through various art and music forms, and using that learning to plan their own community project.
- LAYC will serve a maximum of **70 students in grades 3-5.**
