Afternoon Programs at Bunker Hill ES

These organizations will offer afternoon programming at Bunker Hill ES this summer, from 1:00pm to 5:30 pm. The programs are free of charge and will provide enrichment for students participating in summer school. DCPS is also offering an afternoon program. Students *must* be enrolled in summer school before enrolling in these afternoon programs.

National Center for Children and Families (NCCF): In NCCF's "Imagination Animation Showcase," students will reenact child-friendly movies, such as The Lion King and Finding Dori, using a series of drawings and animation techniques. There will be an end of camp celebration of music, dance, theater, visual arts and crafts presented to family, friends and members of the community.

World Mission: As indicated by our name "World Missions" Adventure Day Academy" children will have an adventure every day going on field trips, swimming, participating in arts and crafts, dancing, being in the book club, playing games/chess, writing stories and other creative adventures.

Girl Scouts: Girl Scouts will offer a session once a week for up to 25 female students participating in all afternoon programs.

DC Public Schools Afternoon Program: The DCPS afterschool program will be based around weekly themes. Students will engage in stories, music and art projects, have daily physical activities, develop a service learning project, and participate in one or more theme-related field trips.
