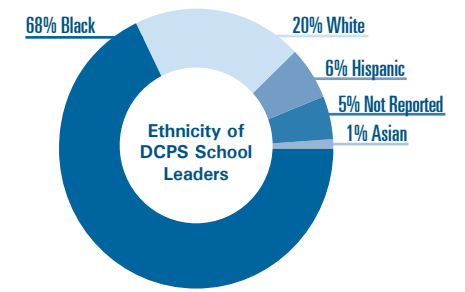

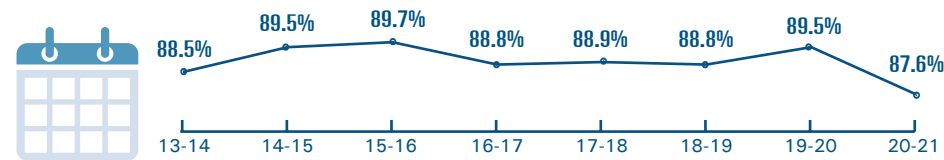

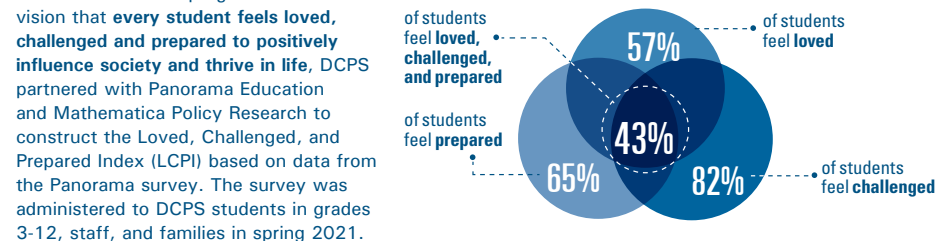

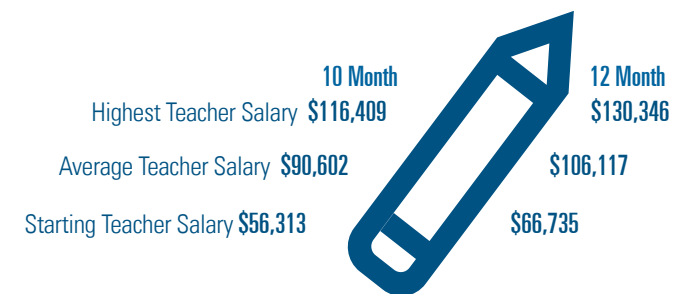

SATISFACTION In order to measure progress toward our vision that every student feels loved, challenged and prepared to positively influence society and thrive in life, DCPS partnered with Panorama Education and Mathematica Policy Research to construct the Loved, Challenged, and Prepared Index (LCPI) based on data from the Panorama survey. The survey was administered to DCPS students in grades 3-12, staff, and families in spring 2021.



TEACHER SALARY

In addition to their base salaries, DCPS teachers also have an opportunity to earn bonuses through IMPACT, DCPS' system for assessing and rewarding the performance of teachers and school-based staff. The below salaries do not include IMPACT^{plus} bonuses and other opportunities for additional compensation.
