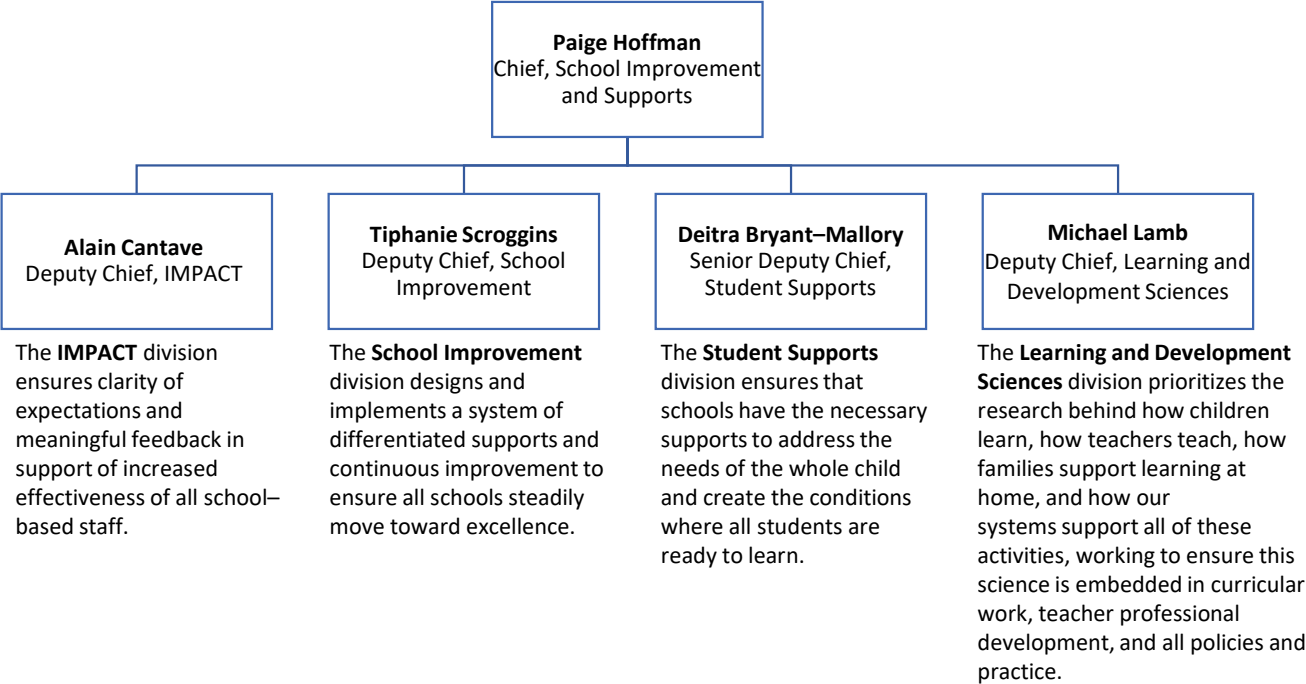
The **School Leader Recruitment, Selection, and Development** division recruits, selects, and develops the best school leaders for DC Public Schools

The **Director** of Schools support major initiatives across all DCPS schools to ensure all schools and departments are supported.

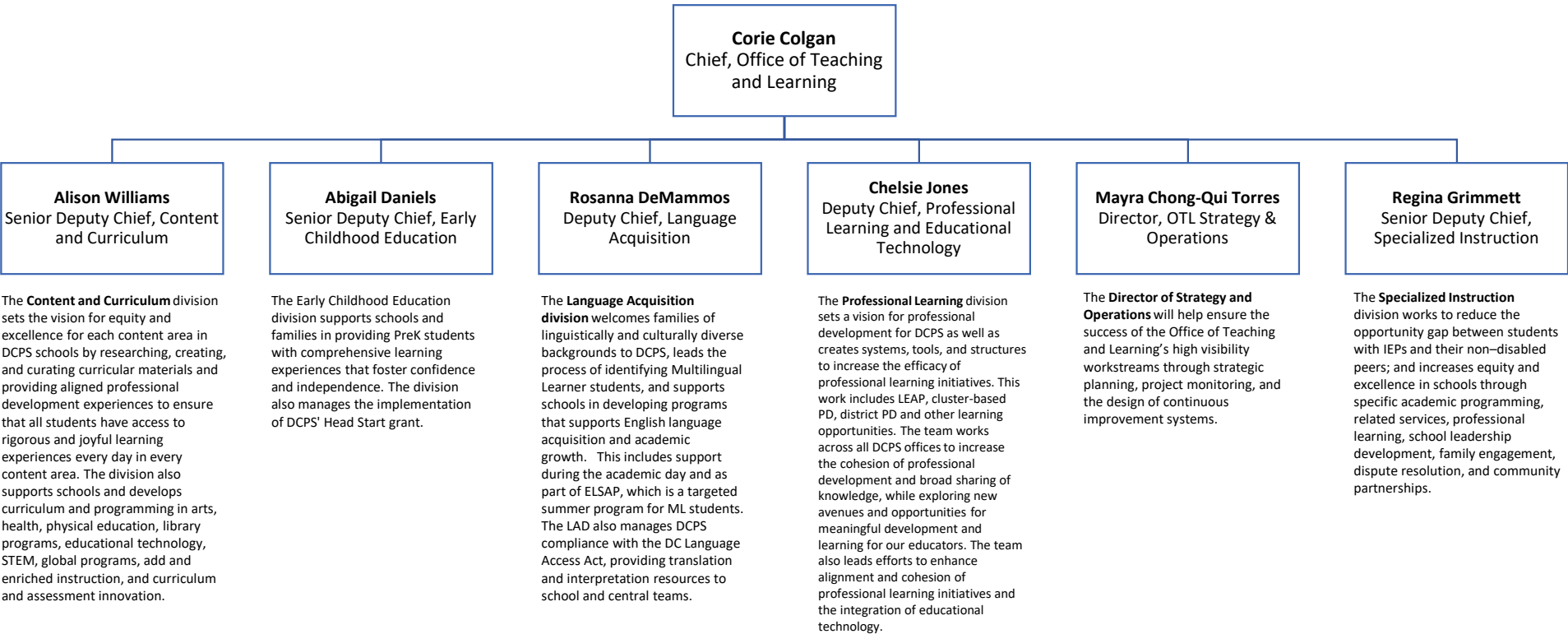

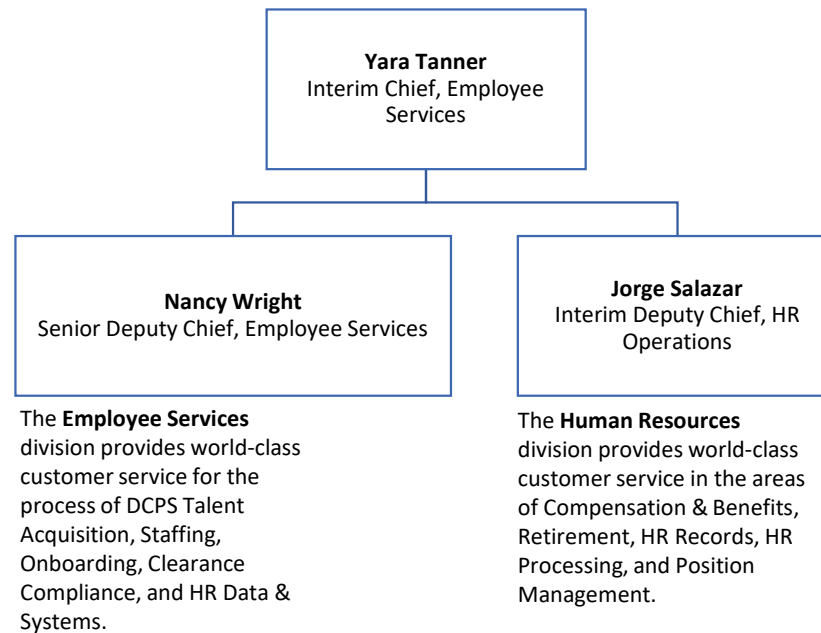

The **Labor Management and Employee Relations (LMER) - Labor Management** team manages and supports staff through highly-sensitive and confidential employee relations, investigations, EEO matters including ADA and sexual harassment labor relations matters, liaising directly with DCPS' union partners. The team also manages the agency's Mandatory Drug and Alcohol Testing (MDAT) program and assists central services staff with employee performance matters. Additionally, this team manages Central Services employee issues and agency-wide adverse action requests.

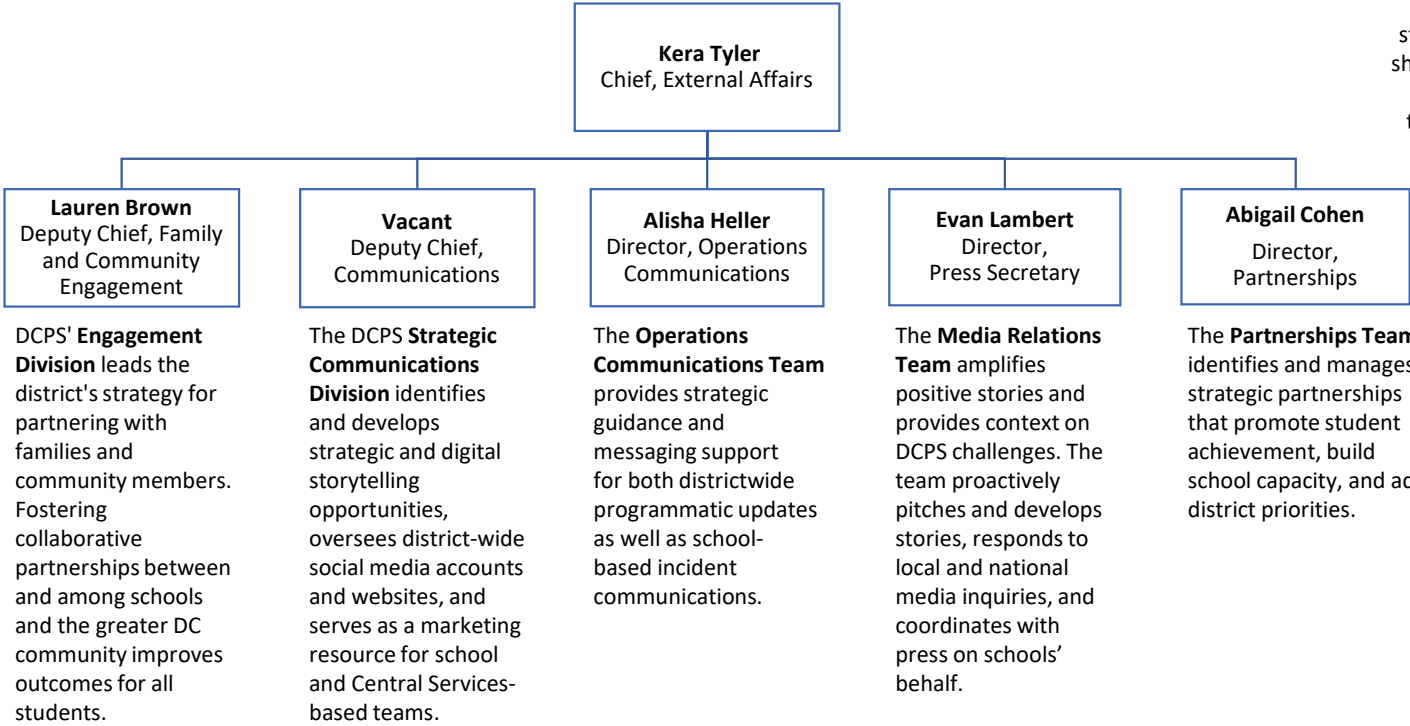

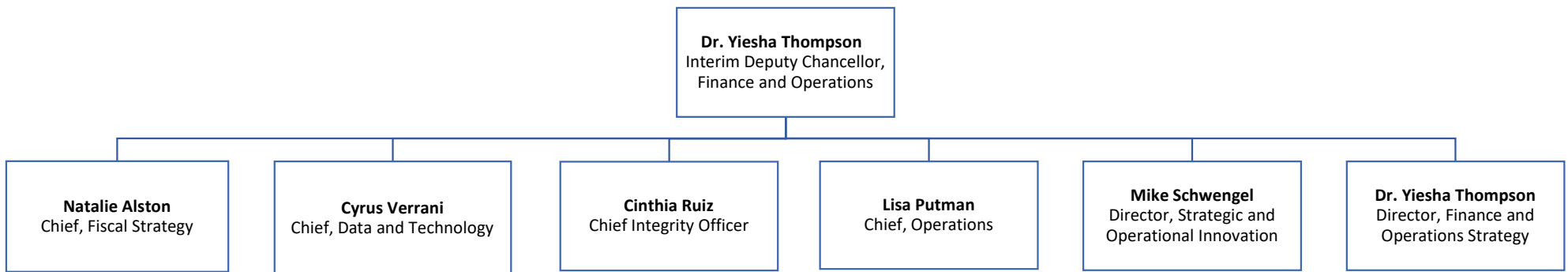


Office of External Affairs

The **Office of Fiscal Strategy (OFS)** consists of the agency divisions of Contracts & Acquisitions, Finance, Fiscal Operations Systems and Operational Finance (Core) teams to ensure consistent, efficient, and equitable budget management and procurement across DCPS offices, divisions and schools and works to streamline operations.

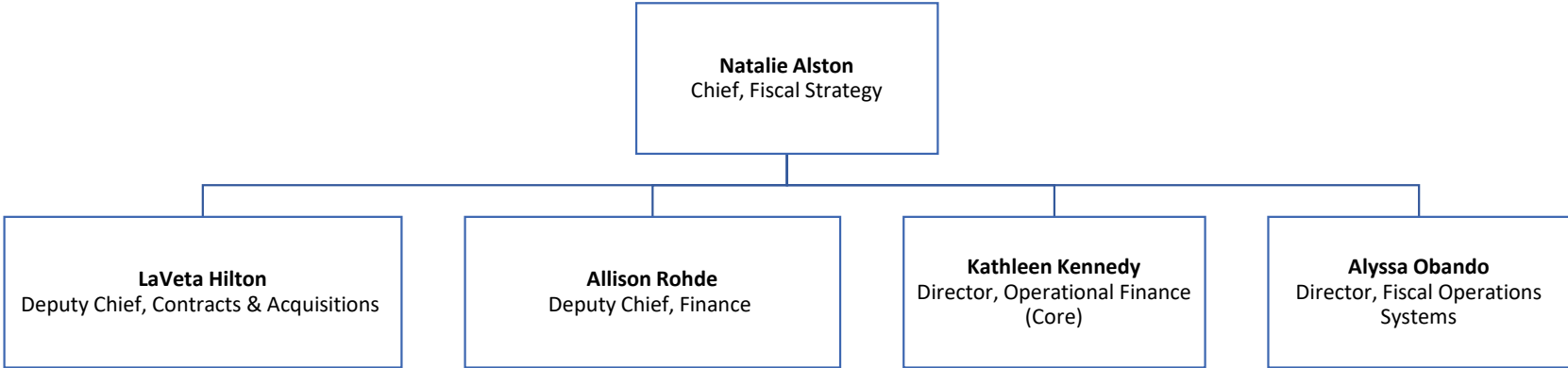
The **Office of Data and Technology (ODT)** supports schools and the district, as a whole, to use technology and data effectively to accelerate student achievement. ODT is comprised of Information Technology, Data, and Strategic Initiatives teams.

The **Office of Integrity (OI)** works to ensure that every student attends school, while promoting growth of the district and resolving concerns surrounding school policies and compliance. OI consists of the Attendance, Enrollment, School Planning, and Integrity teams.

The **Office of Operations (OOO)** is responsible for guiding the operational functions for all schools within the District. OOO includes the Strategic School Operations and Logistics, Food & Nutrition Services, School Security, Facilities and OOO Strategy teams.

The **Office of Finance and Operations Strategy team** leads internal stakeholder engagement to ensure consistent, efficient, and equitable budget management and procurement across DCPS offices and divisions and works to streamline operations throughout the divisions under the purview of the Deputy Chancellor.

Office of Fiscal Strategy



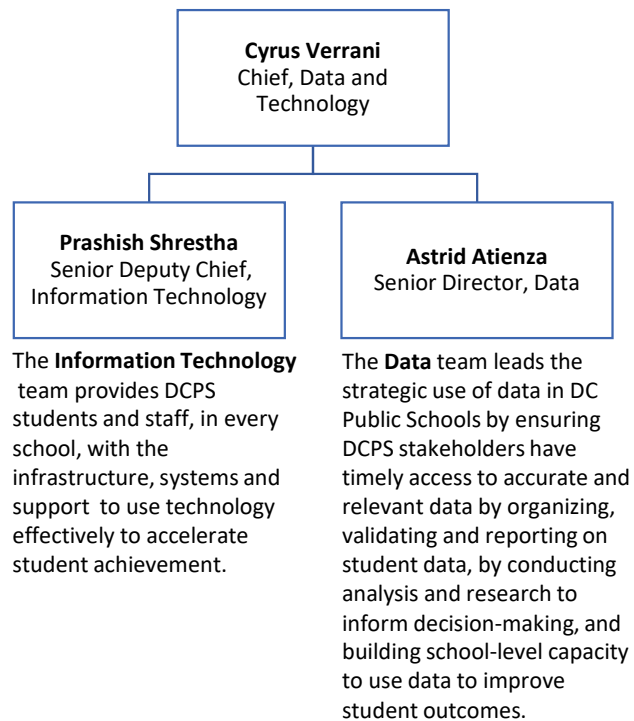
The **Contracts and Acquisitions** division supports schools and Central Office in purchasing to deliver on our mission of educating all children.

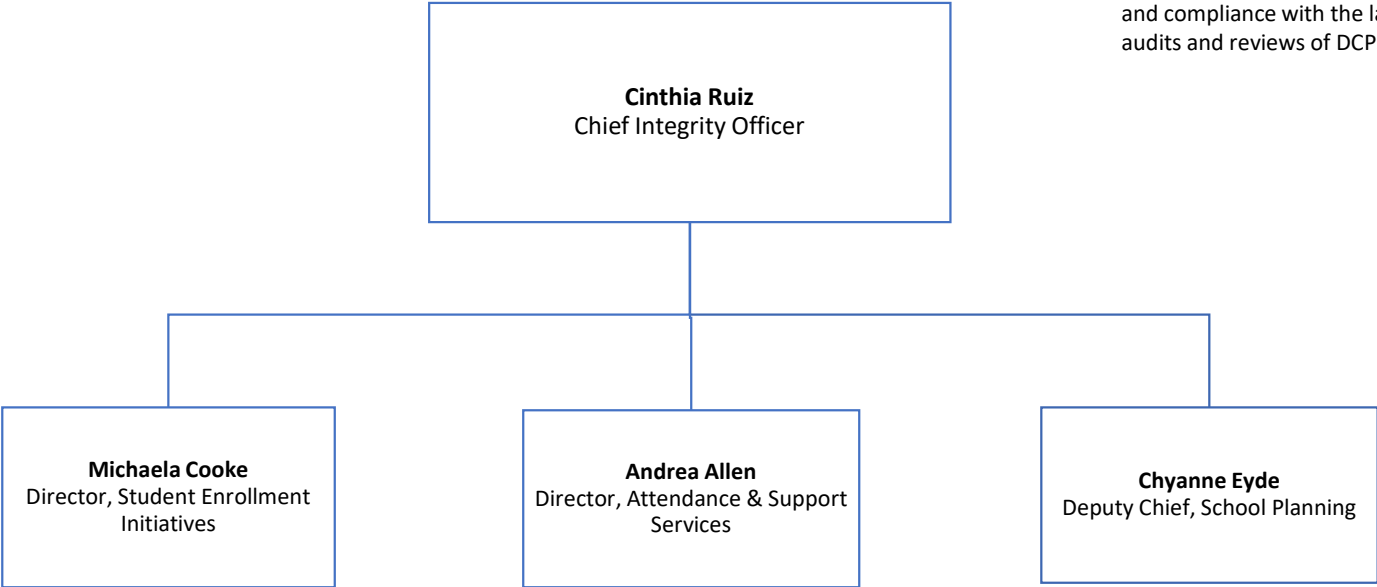
The **Fiscal Operations Systems** division supports schools and central services by leading OFS’s efforts to design and efficient and effective operational finance structures and processes.

Office of Integrity

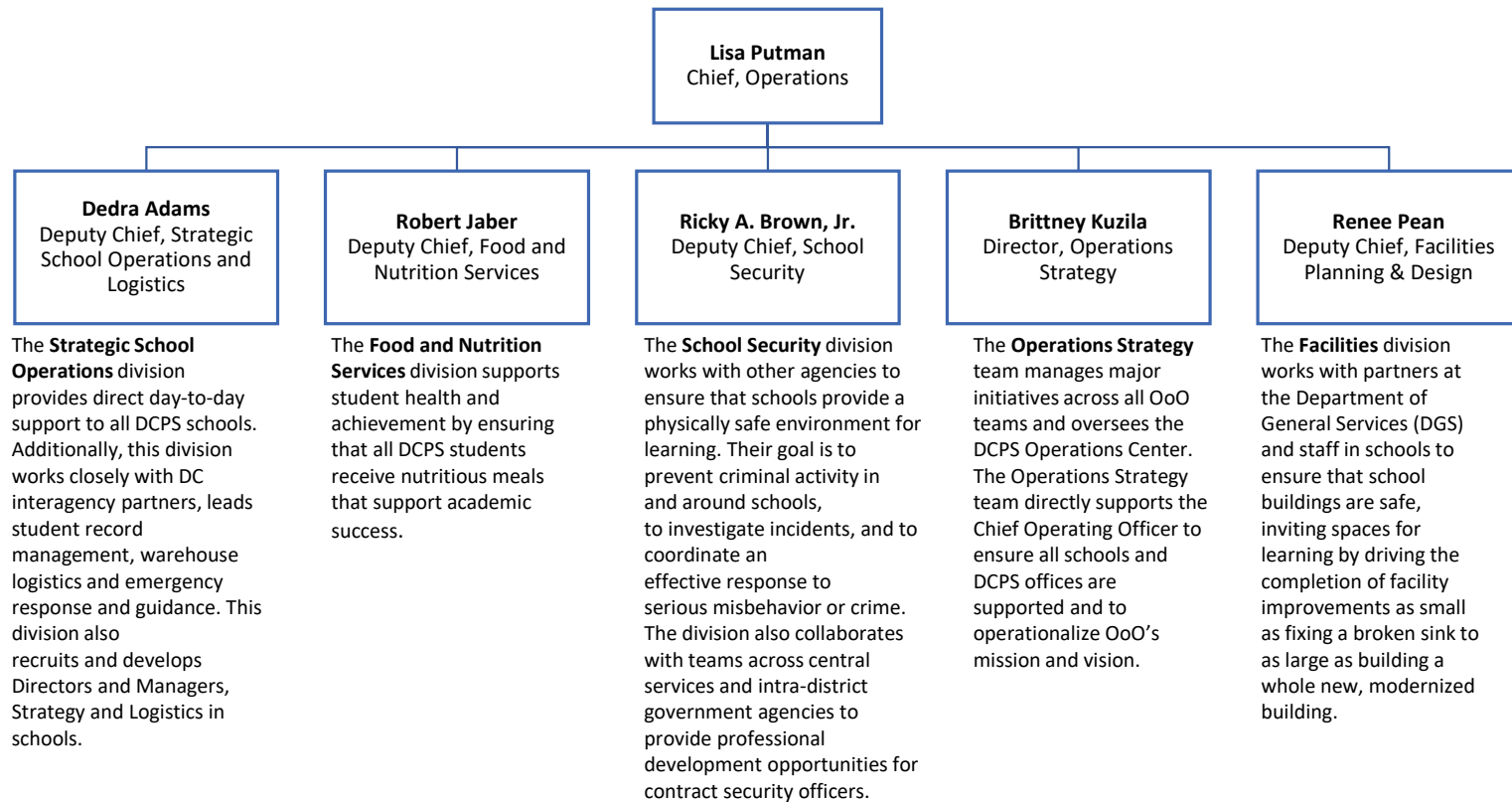
