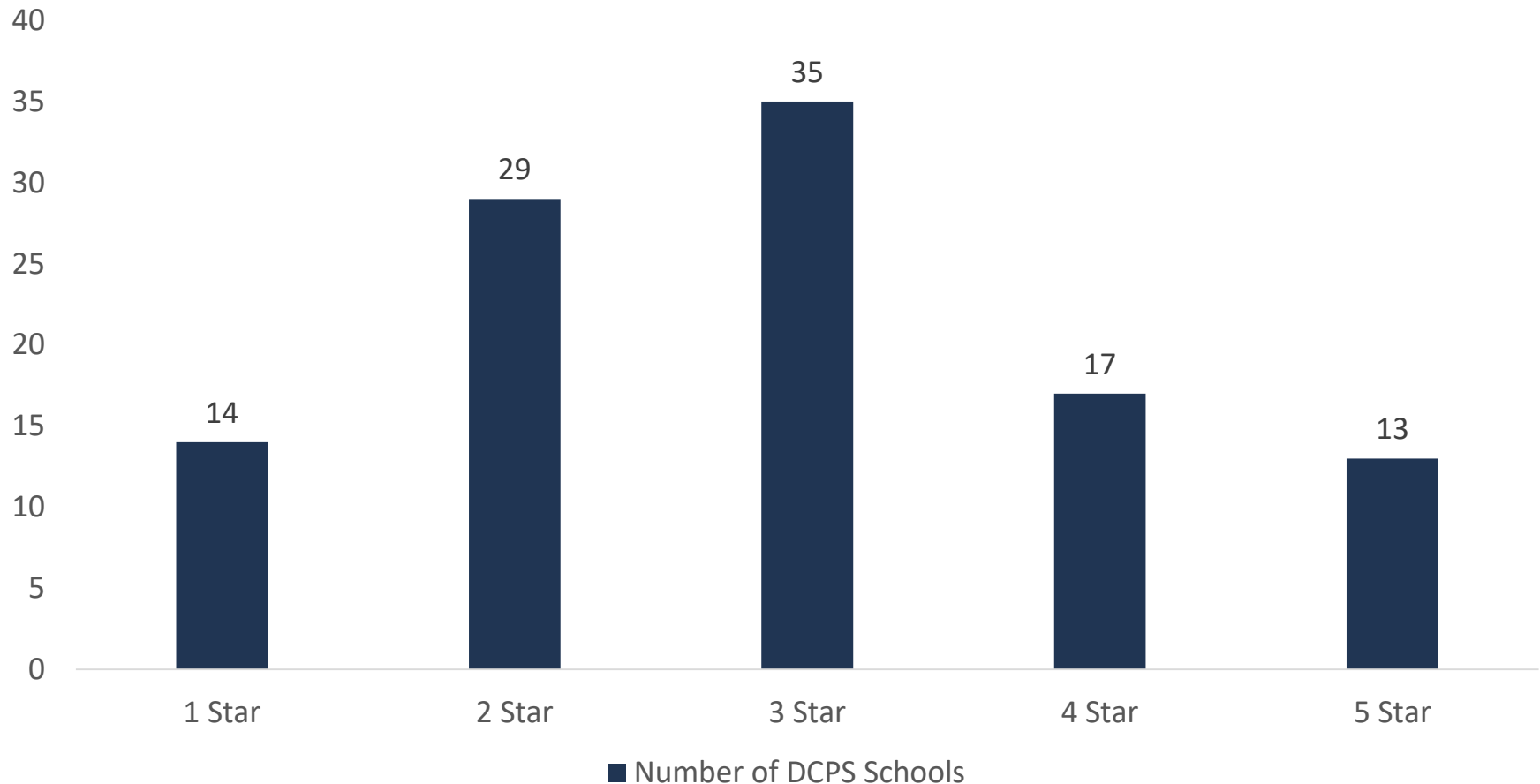


DCPS is committed to promoting **equity and excellence** in all of our schools.

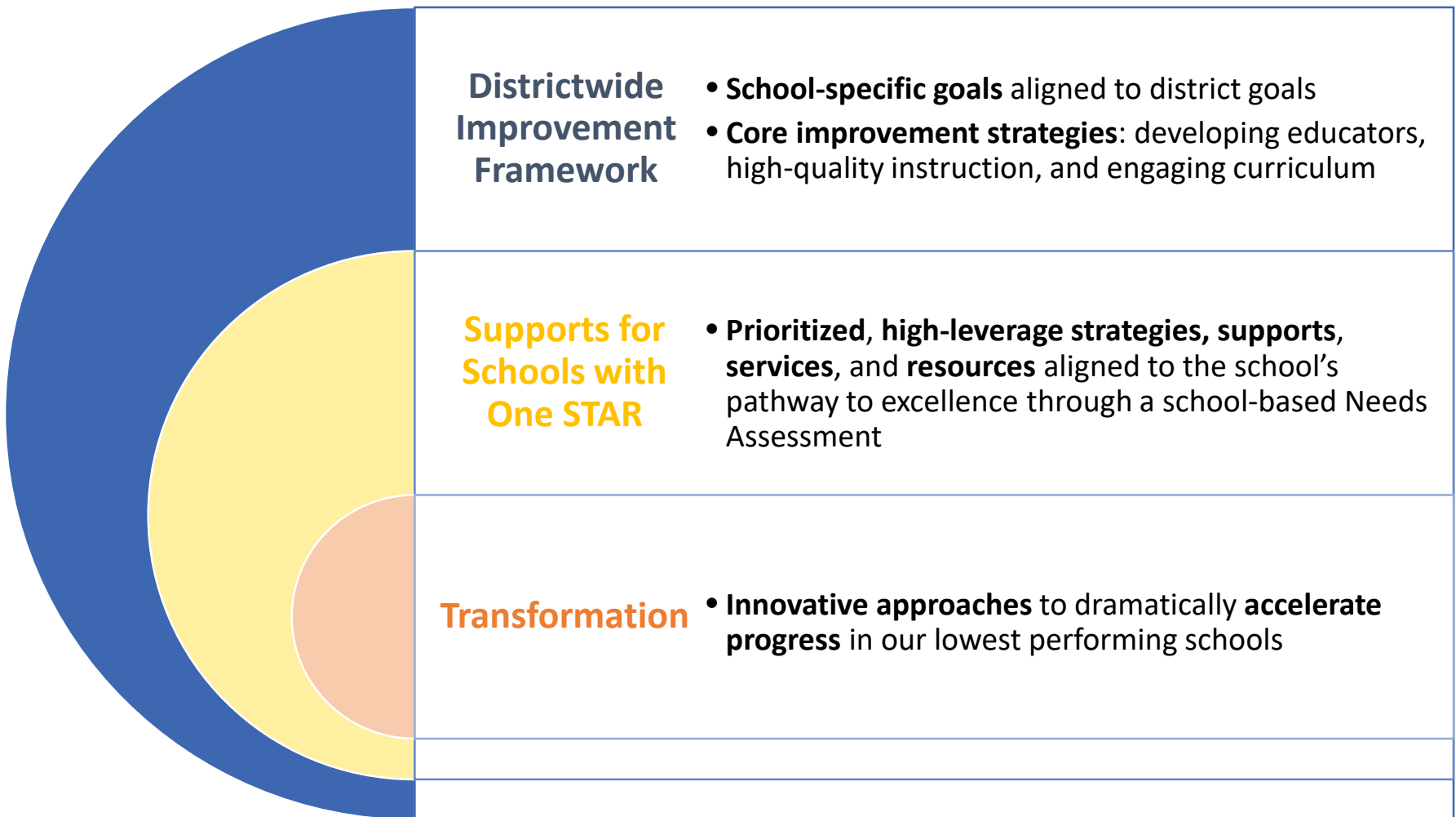
DCPS has developed a Districtwide Improvement Framework that:

We are well-positioned to support our schools on their pathway to excellence.



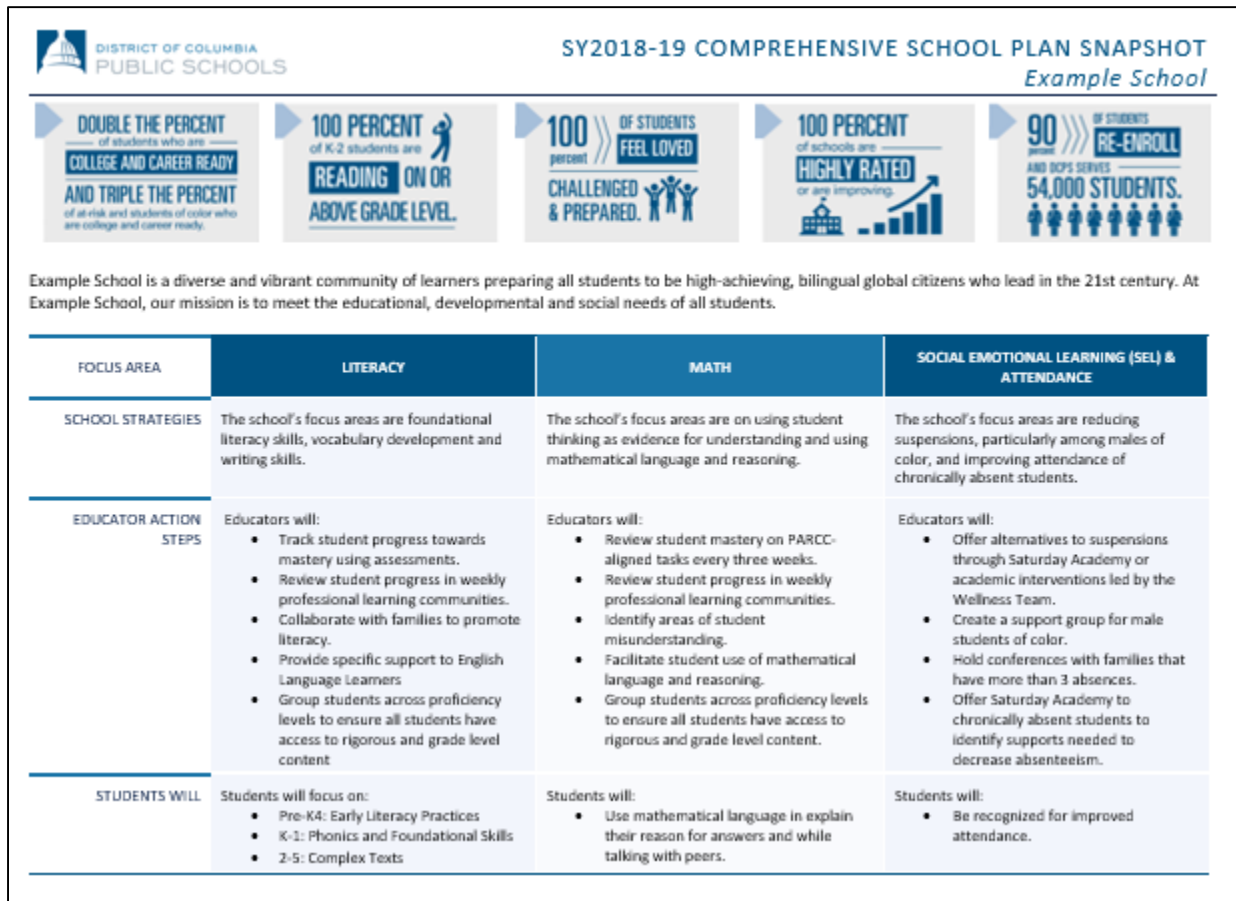
We will take **transformative action** in our schools identified for Comprehensive Support and Improvement.
