What Does the PSAT/NMSQT Measure? The knowledge and skills that research shows are the most essential for college and career readiness and success. The assessment includes the Reading Test, the Writing and Language Test, and the Math Test. A student's total score on the PSAT predicts what their score would be on the SAT. College and Career Readiness Benchmarks: Students with scores at or above the benchmark level (GREEN) have a 75 percent likelihood of passing key first-semester, credit-bearing college courses. Students are considered college- and career-ready when their SAT section scores meet both the Math and the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing benchmarks.
