With that in mind, we are excited to announce that online registration for DCPS' K-7 Summer School 2016 starts on Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>. **Spaces are limited, so please register as soon as possible to secure a seat for your child.**

Please note the following:

1. Only current kindergarten through 7<sup>th</sup> grade (K-7) DCPS students are eligible to participate in this program. If your child does not secure a seat in K-7 Summer School, DCPS will be offering a number of other great opportunities across the district. Check the DCPS website at [dcps.dc.gov](http://dcps.dc.gov) throughout the spring for more information. Unfortunately, this program is not open to prekindergarten or non-DCPS students.
2. Enrollment for K-7 Summer School is done **online** only through [dcps.dc.gov/DCPS/K7summer](http://dcps.dc.gov/DCPS/K7summer). Computers are available at your child's school for you to use to complete the enrollment process if needed. Computers are also available at local DC Public Libraries ([dclibrary.org](http://dclibrary.org)).
3. Information regarding 8<sup>th</sup> grade and High School Summer School will be provided separately.

We look forward to working with you this summer in a learning community dedicated to your child's ongoing success. # Frequently Asked Questions

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## 1. How do I register my child?

Beginning February 22, go to [dcps.dc.gov/DCPS/K7summer](http://dcps.dc.gov/DCPS/K7summer) and enter your child's DCPS ID number, which appears at the beginning of this letter next to your child's name. You may use a computer at your child's school or at a local DC Public Library to complete the registration. The application must be completed on a computer not a mobile device (mobile devices include cellphones and tablets). See page 4 for more information.

## 2. Which students attend summer school?

Summer school is open to every current kindergarten through seventh grade DCPS student on a first-come, first-served basis. **Since the number of seats is limited, please enroll as soon as possible.**

## 3. What is the schedule for summer school?

Summer school will operate every day for five weeks, from June 27 to July 29. There is no school on Independence Day, July 4. The program hours are 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Free breakfast and lunch are included.

## 4. What about afternoon programs?

DCPS is working with a variety of partners to provide enriching afternoon programs at as many summer school sites as possible from 1:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. More information about afternoon offerings and locations will be available closer to the start of summer school on the DCPS website ([dcps.dc.gov](http://dcps.dc.gov)).

## 5. Where is summer school hosted?

The summer school program will operate at eight sites throughout DCPS. (See below.) The chart on page 3 shows you the site to which your child's school and grade have been assigned.

# How to Register Your Student for K-7 Summer School

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Thank you for your interest in registering your child in the summer school program! **You will need to use a computer with Internet access to register.** You may use a computer at your child's school to complete the registration. The application must be completed on a computer not a mobile device (mobile devices include cellphones or tablets). For assistance with completing the registration, ask at the Main Office of your child's school.

**Summer school registration begins on February 22.** Since the number of seats is limited, please enroll as soon as possible.

## What you will need to register for Summer School

1. Only parents and legal guardians may register students.
2. You will need to complete the entire application at one time. (You cannot save and return later.) Completing the registration process will take approximately 5-10 minutes.
3. You will need to have the following information to complete the online registration:
  - Parent/guardian contact information (address, phone number(s), email)
  - Name and phone number of another adult who can be contacted in an emergency
  - Names and phone numbers of anyone authorized to pick the student up at dismissal time
  - Optional information:
    - Medical information, such as names of required medications, allergies, or special needs
    - Dietary restrictions for medical, philosophical or religious reasons

## Steps to Register

1. Go to [dcps.dc.gov/DCPS/K7summer](http://dcps.dc.gov/DCPS/K7summer) in your internet browser on a computer.
  - a. You must type in the address exactly as it appears here, including the part that has capital letters for /DCPS/K.
2. Enter your child's ID number. Your child's ID number appears at the beginning of this letter, next to your child's name.
3. Enter the requested information in the boxes provided.
4. If required, click on the gray arrow to show possible answers to a question (such as "Yes" or "No").
5. When the form is complete, click the "save" button in the upper right hand corner.
6. When you finish, please write down your enrollment confirmation number. If a class is full, you will receive confirmation that your student has been placed on the waitlist.
