



Summer School Afternoon Programs at Plummer ES

These organizations will offer afternoon programming at Plummer ES this summer, from 1:00pm to 5:30 pm. The programs are free of charge and will provide enrichment for students participating in summer school. DCPS is also offering an afternoon program. Students *must* be enrolled in summer school before enrolling in these afternoon programs.

Educational Dimensions, Inc.: Educational Dimensions will provide enrichment opportunities, as well as reading and mathematics instruction. Enrichment is provided by the National Geographic Society and includes field trips for students.

- **Students who participate in this program must receive Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).**

Georgetown Summer Leap: Georgetown University undergraduates provide classroom-based instruction through project-based and experiential lessons, focused on reading, writing and oral fluency, and positive social skills. Summer Leap will also host educational field trips around DC and to Georgetown University's campus to spark students' excitement for college.

Girl Scouts: Girl Scouts will offer a session once a week for up to 25 female students participating in all afternoon programs.

DC Public Schools Afternoon Program: The DCPS afterschool program will be based around weekly themes. Students will engage in stories, music and art projects, have daily physical activities, develop a service learning project, and participate in one or more theme-related field trips.
