Afternoon Programs at Plummer ES

Two partner organizations will offer afternoon programming at Plummer ES this summer, from 1:00 to 5:30 pm. The programs are free of charge and will provide enrichment for students participating in summer school.

Students have to be enrolled in summer school before enrolling in these afternoon programs.

- **Educational Dimensions:** Program participants will enjoy instruction in reading, writing, mathematics, science and social studies through brain-based active engagement. Educational enrichment activities, provided by the National Geographic Society's D. C. Geographic Alliance trained teacher consultants, will be geography-based and will include field experiences, geographical exploration, and a range of project- and problem-based activities.
- Educational Dimensions will serve a maximum of **120 students in grades K-5.**
- **Georgetown Summer Leap:** Georgetown Summer Leap aims to ignite children's passion for lifelong learning. Teams of Georgetown University undergraduates provide classroom-based instruction through project-based and experiential lessons, focused on reading, writing and oral fluency, preparing your child to succeed when they return to school in the fall. In addition to working towards academic goals, we also develop children's positive social skills, like teamwork, self-empowerment, and respect. Finally, through a series of educational field trips around DC and to Georgetown University's campus, we hope to spark children's excitement for college.
- DC Reads will serve a maximum of **80 students in grades 2-5.**
