1. <u>AUTHORIZATION:</u>

The District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS), Wilson Senior High School has an immediate need to procure a 'Tormac PCNC 400 machine along with the following items/services for their CTE Engineering program:

- Delivery and setup of Tormac machine
- Maintenance and continued support throughout contract

3. ESTIMATED COST:

The estimated cost is \$14,530.25 for the proposed period date of award through September 30, 2018.

4. **FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY A SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:**

Logan Hardware is not an authorized reseller of the equipment, they also provide delivery and continued support throughout the set-up process and contract performance period which is essential to the program's success. Logan Hardware is also the only provider of the 'Tormac PCNC400 Machine' in the regional area that provides delivery, set up and the continued support necessary for the students of DCPS. This machine requires additional support and guidance for school based staff, a service that cannot be supplied through other vendors. To ensure the smooth continuation of the DCPS CTE Engineering program at Wilson Senior High School, it is essential that the parts are procured on a sole source basis from Logan Hardware.
