

## **SY19-20 School Feeder Patterns**

Below are the SY19-20 DCPS school feeder patterns. A feeder pattern school is one that a student has the right to attend based on their current school. This assignment only happens during the year a student is moving from the terminal grade of their current school. Note: Feeder patterns are subject to evolve as new student assignment phase-in policies and grandfathering clauses take effect.<sup>1</sup> The feeder patterns reflected below are active for students transitioning grades between SY18-19 and SY19-20.
