Message from DME's Transportation Working Group



The Red Line shutdown from Fort Totten to NoMa-Gallaudet U starts October 29. This shutdown is expected to have significant impacts on all Red Line riders. It is critical that students and families plan ahead by choosing a "Plan A" and a "Plan B". We hope these resources help schools communicate with their communities about the upcoming shutdown, the impacts, and the many alternates that are available.

The Red Line between NoMa-Gallaudet U and Fort Totten will shut down from Saturday, October 29 through Tuesday, November 22.

Do you use the Red Line at Fort Totten Metrorail Station? Plan ahead for this major disruption.

What's happening:

- There will be no Red Line service between NoMe-Gallaudet U and Fort Totten.
 Red Line trains will run in two segments: Shady Grove - NoMe-Gallaudet U and Glermont - Fort Totten.
- Brookland-CUA and Rhode Island Ave stations will be closed.
- Free shuttle buses will replace trains between Fort Totten, Brookland-CUA, Rhode Island Ave and NoMa-Gallaudet U

Plan sheed

- Allow extra travel time and expect crowding on all trains due to much less frequent rush hour Red Line service.
- Use the Green Line for travel between Fort Totten and Gallery Place.
- Consider using multiple alternates to determine the best travel option.

Students using Fort Totten Metrorail Station often travel to and from the following Stations.

Foggy Bottom-GWU	Green Line (transfer to Blue, Silver & Orange Lines at LErriant Plaza Metroral Station)
Georgia Ave-Petworth	Green Line or Metrobus route 60 or 64
NoMe-Gallaudet U	Metrobus route 90" (transfer to route 90 or 92) or Green Line to U Street Metroral Station (transfer to Metrobus route 90 or 92)
Rhode Island Ave	Metrobus route 90" (transfer to HB) or Metrobus route E2 (transfer to route T14 or T19)
Tenleytown-AU	Green Line to Columbia Heights Metronal Station (transfer to Metrobus route H2, H3 or H4) or Metrobus route E4 (transfer to route M4, 31, 33, 30N or 30S)
U Street	Green Line or Metrobus route 64
Union Station	Metrobus route 80° or Green Line to Gallery Place Metrorail Station financier to route 80°, X2 or D6

Surge #10

Fort Totten to NoMa-Gallaudet U 7:00 a.m. Saturday, October 29 until closing, Tuesday, November 22

- The Red Line will be closed between Fort Totten and NoMa-Gallaudet U stations.
- Stations closed: Brookland-CUA and Rhode Island Ave
- Expect large crowds, fewer trains and major delays along the entire Red Line.
- Extremely limited shuttle service available. See inside for details.
- Avoid traveling during rush-hour periods.

TAKE ONE



Rail Options:

- If you're traveling between Gallery Place and Fort Totten, use the Green Line.
- Consider riding MARC's Brunswick Line from Silver Spring or Kensington to Union Station.

Opciones de tren:

- Si usted está viajando entre Gallery Place y Fort Totten, use la línea verde.
- Considere viajar por la línea Brunswick de MARC desde Silver Spring o Kensington hasta la estación de Union Station.

Bus Options:

- Metrobus will operate free, extremely limited shuttle bus service between Fort Totten, Brookland-CUA, Rhode Island Ave and NcMa-Gallaudet U stations.
- Ride On will operate free shuttle bus service between Silver Spring, Takoma and Fort Totten stations every 10 minutes during weekday rush hour.
- Additional weekday rush hour local bus service will operate on Metrobus routes 80, P6 and L2. Additional weekday midday and rush hour service will be provided on Metrobus route S9.

Opciones de autobús:

- Metrobus operará gratis, el servicio de autobús gratulto estará extremadamente limitado entre las estaciones Fort Totten, Brookland CUA, Rhode Island Ave y NoMa-Gallaudet U.
- Ride On operará autobuses de enlace gratuito entre las estaciones de Silver Spring, Takoma y Fort Totten cada 10 minutos los días entre semana durante las horas pico.
- Las rutas de Metrobus 80, P6 y L2 proveerán servicio de autobús adicional los días entre semana durante las horas pico. La ruta S9 proveerá servicio de autobús adicional los días entre semana al mediodía y durante las horas pico.

Parking Options:

f you currently park at a Red Line station, consider other Park & Ride facilities or parking at a Green Line station.

WMATA outreach workers will be distributing these "Take One" flyers to riders at various affected stations.

KEY MESSAGES



- The Red Line will be closed between Fort Totten and NoMa from October 29 through November 22.
- There will be significant disruption to riders on the Red Line but there are lots of alternatives, including the Green Line.
- Students and families should plan ahead. Use the student flyers, DDOT's commute challenge on safetrack.goDCgo.com, or call WMATA's customer service to select a Plan A and a Plan B and try them out before the first day of the shutdown.
- If students normally use the Red Line, consider bus alternatives.
- The free bus shuttle "bridge" should be a last resort because service will be very limited and there may be long lines.
- Expect your commute to take longer than usual and be more crowded than usual. Students may need to set their alarms earlier than normal.



SAMPLE "ROBO-CALL" SCRIPT

As is, this script may take anywhere from 55 to 75 seconds, depending on the speed of the speaker. Please feel free to edit and adapt in whatever way makes sense for your school community.

"Hello [Insert Name of School/LEA] Community. This is a reminder that Metro's next SafeTrack Safety Surge starts Saturday, October 29 and will last until Tuesday, November 22. Metro's Red Line will be shut down from Fort Totten to NoMa Gallaudet. This means that both the Brookland and Rhode Island Avenue stations will be closed. Although free shuttle buses will replace trains between Fort Totten, Brookland-CUA, Rhode Island Ave, and NoMa-Gallaudet U stations, students who ride the Red Line should plan ahead and find alternate routes. The Red Line will be extremely crowded, and there may be long waits for the limited shuttle buses. Please consider multiple alternates to determine the best travel option. To help you plan, Metro has produced student flyers, which are available online [or through your school]. RED LINE SHUTDOWN FROM NOMA-GALLAUDET TO FORT TOTTEN



From October 29 to November 22, Red Line rail service will not operate between Fort Totten and NoMa-Gallaudet stations. As a result, two stations (Brookland and Rhode Island Avenue) will be closed. Although free shuttle buses will replace trains between Fort Totten, Brookland-CUA, Rhode Island Ave, and NoMa-Gallaudet U stations, students who ride the Red Line should plan ahead and find alternate routes.

The Red Line will be **extremely crowded**, and there may be long waits for the limited shuttle buses. Please consider multiple alternates to determine the best travel option. You may want to practice your alternate routes before the first school day of the surge (October 31).

To help you plan, Metro has produced student flyers, which are available <u>online</u>. 

The size and shape of images (height, width, and orientation) are the elements that will most influence how an image will appear in a social media stream.

SOCIAL MEDIA IMAGES



1.9:1 ratio (these are 600x315)





In general, images and links shared on Facebook via Timeline or Newsfeed should be 1.91:1 ratio.

Many sites recommend that images be 1200x630.

The minimum dimensions for an image generated from a shared link are 200x200.

There is no minimum for images shared via Timeline nor Newsfeed.
