The previously issued purchase order was executed in December of 2015 (PO535716) for website development and hosting for the initial launch of <u>www.dcpsinternships.org</u> on behalf of the Office of College and Career. The website resulted in user friendly and easily accessible page for students and central office school program administrators to utilize for college preparation.

This is a continuation of the current website and the vendor will further enhance the experience for students and capture the goals of the Office of College and Career to prepare students for college.
