The finishing Trades Institute and the Washington DC Apprenticeship Training Directors Association facilitates the Multi-Craft Core Curriculum for DCPS seniors to implement the Building Trades Apprenticeship Readiness Program with DCPS career Bridge Seniors. Through this partnership, seniors will receive access to the Multi-Craft Core Curriculum and be prepared to enter apprenticeship programs after graduation.

FTI is the only organization in the metropolitan region with a partnership with multiple building trade unions; those partnerships would provide credit to the students for the instruction received under FTI and facilitate and expedited entrance to the official building trade apprenticeship program upon the student's successful completion of FTI's program.
