respondent group.


Next, there is a summary page for each

Schools Framework:


- ➔ **Teaching and Learning:** Does the school






# OVERVIEW OF MURCH'S SURVEY RESULTS

## I am strongly supported within my school.




## Would you recommend that a friend send his or her child to this school?



## Survey Scales for Murch's Scorecard

Four scores on each school's DCPS Scorecard will be derived from responses to the Stakeholder Surveys. 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




