respondent group.


Next, there is a summary page for each

Schools Framework:


- ➔ **Teaching and Learning:** Does the school emphasize instruction and hold students to high expectations for achievement?




OVERVIEW OF PEABODY'S SURVEY RESULTS




Would you recommend that a friend send his or her child to this school?



Survey Scales for Peabody's Scorecard
