



Summer School Afternoon Programs at Thomson ES

These organizations will offer afternoon programming at Thomson ES this summer, from 1:00pm to 5:30 pm. The programs are free of charge and will provide enrichment for students participating in summer school. DCPS is also offering an afternoon program. Students *must* be enrolled in summer school before enrolling in these afternoon programs.

Asian American Lead (AA Lead): The AA LEAD summer program will help students learn, explore their own identities, and help build leadership skills through fun projects and exciting field trips. Students will participate in workshops focused on STEM, discovery, culture, health, identity, and leadership.

- **Preference is given to students who receive Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).**

Girl Scouts: Girl Scouts will offer a session once a week for up to 25 female students participating in all afternoon programs.

DC Public Schools Afternoon Program: The DCPS afterschool program will be based around weekly themes. Students will engage in stories, music and art projects, have daily physical activities, develop a service learning project, and participate in one or more theme-related field trips.
