Summer Trek: Summer Trek is a summer experiential learning program designed to engage middle school students as community problem-solvers. Through a series of dynamic and highly motivating project-based activities, students build upon their interests and develop academic literacy and college/career readiness skills and expertise as they explore ways to make positive contributions to their communities and the world.

- Summer Trek serves students in current **grades 5 through 8 only**.

World Mission: As indicated by our name "World Missions" Adventure Day Academy" children will have an adventure every day going on field trips, swimming, participating in arts and crafts, dancing, being in the book club, playing games/chess, writing stories and other creative adventures.

Girl Scouts: Girl Scouts will offer a session once a week for up to 25 female students participating in all afternoon programs.

DC Public Schools Afternoon Program: The DCPS afterschool program will be based around weekly themes. Students will engage in stories, music and art projects, have daily physical activities, develop a service learning project, and participate in one or more theme-related field trips.
